Sheffield

Sheffield is the natural location for the 41st BMSS Annual Meeting. Located close to the geographic center of the UK it provides an easily accessible and affordable venue - anchored by the research groups' of Professor Malcolm Clench and Professor Simona Francese.

Mass Spectrometry

The Conference Venue

The SHU City Campus, just two minutes walk from Sheffield station, offers convenient and modern facilities in the heart of the city. The Pennine & Peak lecture theatres and the Hallam Mezzanine-Concourse have been recently refurbished and will provide the scientific and social hub of BMSS41.





Height Restrictions:

Hallam Hall: 4.8m Hallam View: 2.3m Hallam Central: 3.3m Mezzanine: 2.1m (Plot #1), and 2.9m (Plots # 8&9)

Vehicular Access Restrictions:

The SHU Owen Building has a dedicated loading bay with direct road access. Deliveries may be made in person or with the assistance of a third party courier/expediter. Exhibitors who intend to make delivery in person are advised that on-site parking is **NOT** available.


Lift Restrictions:
