...Location, Location, Location


Manchester



Well Connected

Manchester is well connected to the UK motorway and rail networks. **Manchester International Airport** is connected to the city center by both direct rail and Metrolink tram services. Within the city the Metrolink tram and bus services make getting around simple and inexpensive.

The Conference Venue

The Royal Northern College of Music (RNCM) will provide a stunning modern setting for the 40th BMSS Annual Meeting. Conveniently located on Oxford Road, at the heart of Manchester's University Quarter, and well connected by public transport.

The RNCM provides excellent lecture theatres. The main concourse, tiered over three interconnected levels, will host the vendor exhibition. The RNCM's grand public spaces will provide an architecturally impressive backdrop for interaction with fellow delegates and the Curry Night Social.





The Curry Night Social

Manchester's affair with curry began in the 50s. In the 80s & 90s the 'Curry Mile', in Rusholme, became the epicentre for food from the Indian subcontinent. In its heyday the curry mile offered mainly north Indian, or Punjabi, cooking. In recent times south Indian, typically Keralan, style food is becoming popular throughout the city.

The BMSS40 Curry Night & Social Evening, at the RNCM, will continue the affair! Live music will be provided by alumni of the RNCM.

The Conference Dinner

The Hall of Fame at the core of the National Football Museum will be the spectacular setting for the BMSS40 conference dinner. Pre-dinner drinks will be served on the mezzanine floors that cascade through the building and overlook the hall of fame.

The museum is housed in the Urbis building with its iconic sloping glass form and adiabatic cooling system - making it one of the most energy efficient buildings in Britain. Urbis was opened in 2002 as part of the redevelopment of Manchester's Exchange Square district with a convenient Metrolink (tram) stop.
